SMOKE HOOD



Invented by Garrett Morgan

Patent in 1914.

1st used in workers trapped in water

Intake tunnel in Ohio.

Workers used to protect against

Smoke and to breathe



Inspired to make it due to seeing firefighters struggling to breathe in Smoky conditions.

-He formed National Safety Device Company.

-Over 500 cities in the North, US Army and Navy. They were used in WW1.

-He had trouble selling in The South. He hired actor friend sell product to Southern states and it was effective.

JAZZ

Originated in African American communities in New Orleans, Louisiana

- Roots in blues and ragtime
- Became popular nation wide
- Influenced by European and American classical music, slave folk sounds. Hymns from black spirituals.
- Famous Jazz Musicians: Duke Ellington, Charlie Parker, Thelonious Monk, Miles Davis, Dizzy Gillespie, Louis Armstrong
