The beginning..

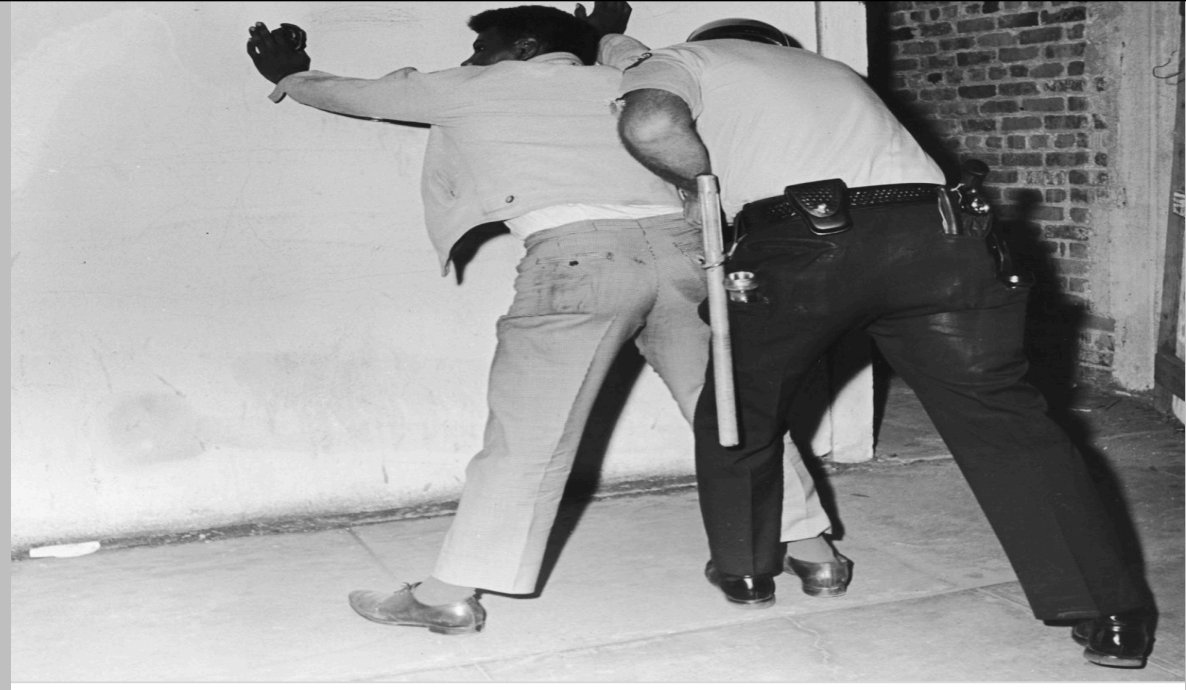


- During the 1960's, Blacks weren't seen equal
- Blacks weren't allowed to dine beside Whites
- Blacks were violated physically, emotionally, and verbally
- Were seen as animals



- Blacks had to not only be segregated due to their skin color but also segregated within schools
- Black students weren't allowed to use the same bathroom as whites
- Blacks couldn't use the same water fountain as their white peers
- Blacks weren't allowed to use the same school building as Whites
- Blacks level education was very low and was presented poorly to them
- Blacks had to sit in one classroom, no matter the grade, and had to learn the same thing everyone else was learning

- Black people also dealt with brutality treatment from police officers due to their skin color
- Blacks were beaten badly and was treated with a lot aggression
- Blacks would be arrested in handle in jail cells that were dirty and had rats in it
- Blacks would be shot with water hoses, bitten by dogs, and even had stink bombs thrown within their crowds
- Police enforcement would use racial slurs to get Blacks to back down from their
- Sometimes would be chained up for hours, singing spirituals that would set them free from their horror and pain



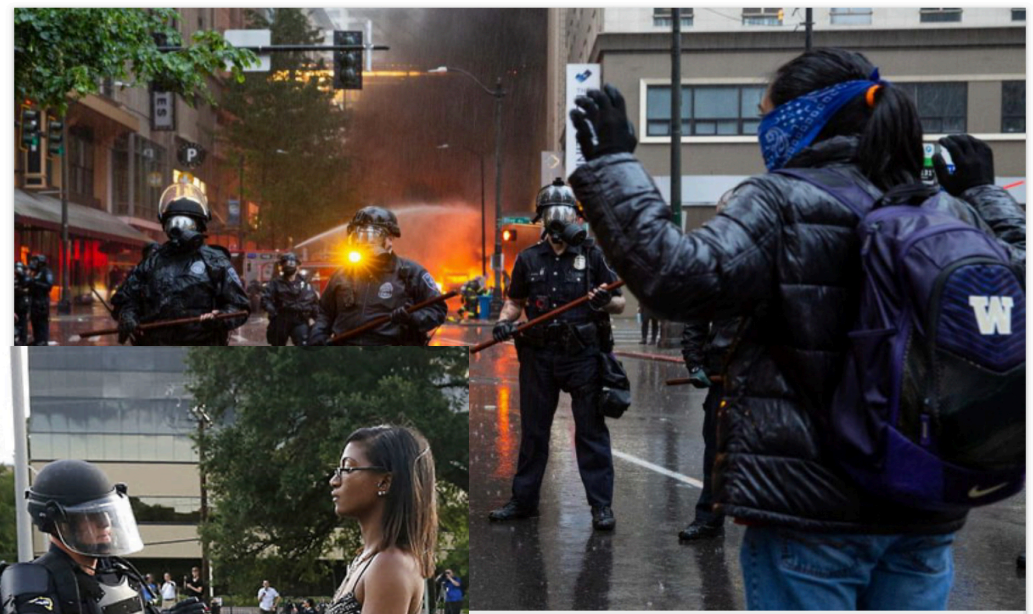
Current Events...

- Even after all the fight Blacks still aren't seen equal to Whites
 - White people believe they could gentrify Black neighborhoods due to it being a “ Low income” area
 - Whites also look at Black like we don't belong
 - Whites also distance themselves when they see a crowd of Black people around
 - Some White managers don't hire Black people either because of their name or skin color



- Schooling for whites and blacks within this century is also segregated
- Black students who attend these HBCU's have to pay a load of money for education
- PWI's on the other hand are funded by different schools, company's or even parents
- Some schools with 90% of White students are taught advanced while other schools full of black people are taught the "norm" of education

- Currently police brutality has become more aggressive
- Blacks are being killed due to racial inequality within the criminal justice system
- Blacks civil rights are violated everyday due to aggressive force
- A lot of this aggression has caused a lot of innocent Black lives to end



Important amendments

- 13th amendment ~ Neither slavery nor involuntary servitude, except as a punishment for crime whereof the party shall have been duly convicted, shall exist within the United States
- 14th amendment~ All persons born or naturalized in the United States and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States and of the State wherein they reside. No State shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of citizens of the United States; nor shall any State deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws.
- 15th amendment~ The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude.
